Decision No. $\qquad$ 85041 BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMSSION OF IEE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Natter of the Application of NAllicert E. Adams doing business as NHCK'S DETIVERY SERVICE for authority to depart from the minimum rates, rules and regulations of Minfmm Rate Tariff No. 2, pursuant to the provistons of Section 3666 of the PubIfc Etilities Code.

Appilcation No. 55901 (Filed August 28, 1975)

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Applicant Milificent E. Adame, dofng business as Nick's Delivery Service, operates as a bigbway permit carrier of general comodities. By this application authority is sought to deviate from the mintmun rates prescribed in Minim Race Tariff 2 (NRI 2) and n Rate Tariff I-B (MRT I-B) for the transportation of shipments welghing 100 pounds or less between points within Alameda and Contra Costa Countfes.

Applicant proposes to conduct a percel delivery service competing with existing carriers which specialize in the transportation of swall shfpments or packsges, generally welghing less tham 100 poinds. On muerous occastons in the past this Comission has granted to these carriers authoifty to assess rates which are less tinan or at vaifence with the charges set forth in $\mathrm{N} R I 2$.

Sfnce the applicant must of mecessity compete with these and other similarly situated carriers previously authorized by the Comission to assess rates which are at varlance with the charges established in IRIs 2 and I-B, she seek hereln sfmilar rate relief to assess charges which are basicaliy in accord with those cherges now beling assessed by the above-described carriers pursuant to autionity of this Comission.

The relief sought berein is consistent with the Commission' 0 position as expressed in J. S. Aaronson (1961) 58 CPUC 533. Moreover, if the sought relief is granted, applicant would then enjoy an equality of competitive opportanity with other parcel delivery cariters serviag the same general area.

The Comission finds that:

1. The rates, rules, and charges nomed in MRTs 2 and 1-B are not eppropriate, reasowable, or otherwise proper for the parcel Celivery service performed by applicant.
2. The sought exemption from the otherwise governing provisions of MRXs 2 and $1-B$ for the transportation of shipments weighing 100 pornds or less at rates and cheiges not less than those specified in Appendix A hereof bas been shown to be reasonable.
3. The minimum rate exemption authozity as proposed by epplicent fuily conforms with the criteria prescribed in Aaronson, supra.
4. A pubilic hearint is not necessery.

The Comission conclades that Application No. 55901 should be granted to the extent set forth in the followizg order.

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IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Milifcent E. Adams, doing business as Mick's Delivery Service, is authorized to transport shipments weighing 100 pounds or less at rates less then and different from the otherwise governing minn rates to the extent and in the moaner set forth in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
2. The authority granted hereIn shall expire on December 3I, 1075 unless sooner modified, canceled, or extended by order of the Commission.

## Application

2. The rates set forth herefn are applicable only to the transportation of pacieages wefghing 100 pounds or less between points set forth berein.
3. The rate for the transportation of a package between points within the same area shall be the rate provided in the attached Rate Schedule for that area.
4. The rate for the transportation of a package between points in two areas shall be the rate applicable to the bigher of the two areas, as prescribed in the attached Rate Schedule.
5. A charge of 50 cents shall be made for each pickup stop at a consignor's place of business in addition to the charge determined by paragraphs 2 or 3 above.

## Rules and Restrictions

1. No package welghing in excess of 100 pounds nor measuring more than 160 inches (length and girth comblned) will be accepted for delivery. A maximum weight of 100 pounds destined for a single consignee will be picked up at any one time.
2. Sbipper will pay all charges.
3. Carrier will make pickups only on weekdays--Monday through Friday; no Saturday, Sunday, or holiday picioups will be made.
4. Carrier will be liable to shipper for loss of or dawage to packages of merchandise entrusted to it for delivery in the amount of 80 percent of the selling price thereof, but not to exceed $\$ 100$ for any one package, such limitations to be effective whether or not such loss or damage has been due to the negifgence of the delivery service.
5. An additional charge of 85 cents will be assessed for each C.O.D. collection.

6. Caxifer will accept checiks tendered by consignee for C.O.D. packages, unless shipper gives written instructions on C.O.D. delivery address tag and on C.O.D. manifest to collect cash ocly. Carrier will not assume responsibility for validity of checks tendered in payment of C.O.D. collections. If carrier fails to collect any C.O.D. and such failure is not reported by the consigmor to the carrier within 15 days after recelpt by the delivery company of the package bearing such C.O.D., the consignor shail be deemed to bave waived its right to hold the delivery company responsible for such failure.
7. The return of a package, which for any reason is returned to the consignor, after once baving been delivered to the correct address, will be charged for at the same rate as charged for the original delfvery thereof, provided the order to return the package is given the carrier by, and the charges are paid by, the original consignor, or his agent.
8. The rate herein will not apply to any silipment with an origin and destination wholly within a single city.
9. The rate herein will apply only to wholesale parcel delivery service. Wholesale parcel deifvery service means the transportation of packages and parcels moving between wholesalers, jobbers, dealers, distributors, industries, retail stores, offices, comexcial houses, schools, hospitals, clabs, govermental agencies, and institutions.
