In the Matter of the Application of THE EUREXA ICE AND COLD STORAGE COMPANY For an Increase in Rates.

Application No. 55653 (Filed April 28, 2975 )

## Q PINTON

Applicant is a public utility warehouseman engaged in the storage of comodities requiring refrigeration at Eureka. Applicant seeks to increase its rates by 20 percent. Authority is also requested in effecting the increase to drop fractions of less than one-half cent and fncrease fractions of one-half cent or greater to the next whole cent.

Notice of the proposed increase was sent to each of applicant's storers. One of applicant's storers protested the appIication. By letter dated September II, 1975 the protestant advised it was withdrawing its protest.

Applicant's rates were last adjusted pursuant to authority grantel by Decision No. 81701 dated July 31, 1973 in Application No. 53926.

Unde= present rates applicant sustained a loss in the public utility portion of its business of $\$ 2,944$ in 1974. Taking into consideration the 20 percent increase sought by this spplication, as well as increased cost of operations, applicant on the basis of business done in 1974 would have enjoyed a profit of $\$ 10,259$ after taxes, and an operating ratio of 94.4 percent coupled with a rate of return of 8.1 percent. While an operating ratio of 94.4 percent is projected, applicant anticipates a drop of approximately 1,$000 ; 000$ pounds in 1975 due to a poor crab season and customers' expansion of
their own storage facilities. Applicant believes, however, that under the 20 percent increase bere proposed, it can remain in business for the next two years without serfously jeopardizing its overall financial position.

1. Applicant's rates were last adjusted by Decision No. 81701 dated July 3I, 1973 Application No. 53926.
2. Since applicant's rates were last adjusted, it has experienced increases in operating expenses.
3. Under the increase soaght herein applicant estimates it will realize additional revenue of $\{30,6 \in 1$, an operating ratio, after taxes, of 94.4 percent, and a rate of Ietura, after taxes, of 8.1 percent provided storage is the same level as in 1974.
4. The proposed increases bave been shown to be justified.
5. A public hearing is not necessary. The Comoission concludes that Appiication No. 55653 should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Eureka Ice and Cold Storage Company is authorized to astablisk the increased rates proposed in Application No. 55653. Taniff poblications authorized to be made as a result of this order shali be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than ten days after the effective Iate of this order on not less than ten days' notice to the Comaission and to the public.
2. The authority shall expire unless exercised within ninety deys after the effentive date of this order.
3. The authority granted by this order is subject to the express condition that applicant will never urge before this Commission in any proceeding under Section 734 of the Public Utilities Code, or in any other proceeding, that this opinion and order constitute a finding of fact of the reasonableness of any particular rate or charge. The filing of rates and charges pursuant to this order will be construed as a consent to this condition.
