## SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 85101, entered today in Case No. 5432 (Petition for Modification No. 866), et al., the Commission found that various minimum rate tariffs should be amended to reflect the adoption of Supplement 13 to National Motor Freight Classification NWF 100 B. The decision also provided that Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 9-B and 19 should be amended by separate order to minimize duplication of tariff distribution.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Minimum Rate Tariff 1-B (Appendix B of Decision No. 65834, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective December 13, 1975, Nineteenth Revised Page 18-A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 2. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision No. 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective December 13, 1975, Twenty-second Revised Page 18, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

- 3. Winimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision No. 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein to become effective December 13, 1975, Forty-seventh Revised Page 16, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
- 4. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decisions Nos. 41363, 65834 and 67766, as amended, are hereby directed to establish in their tariffs the increases necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered herein.
- 5. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein shall be made effective December 13, 1975, on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public and tariff publications which are authorized but not required to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than December 13, 1975, and may be made effective on not less than one days's notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than February 13, 1976.
- 6. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the amendments authorized hereinabove, are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the amendments published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.
- 7. In all other respects Decisions Nos. 41363, 65834 and 67766, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
