SECOND INTERIM OPINION

Decision No. 84288 dated April 1, 1975 authorized Melvin-A. Deaile, dba Deaile Trucking (applicant), to transport Chicoite from McKittrick to Richmond for 52½ cents per cwt, subject to a minimum weight of 50,000 pounds. That authority expired October 1, 1975.

The rates authorized by Decision No. 84288 were based on preliminary cost estimates. It was expected that actual costs and revenue data would be presented for consideration at a public hearing to be scheduled. Applicant has advised that only 14 shipments were handled pursuant to the authorized rates. The bulk of the transportation had been accomplished by rail. It is understood that a reinstatement of the deviated rate will permit applicant to participate in a significant amount of this traffic, permitting the collection of meaningful operating data.

After consideration we find that the authority established by Decision No. 84288 should be reinstated for a six-month period. Applicant will be authorized to depart from the governing minimum rates to the extent provided in the following order.

SECOND INTERIM ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- l. Melvin A. Deaile, doing business as Deaile Trucking, is authorized to depart from the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 by charging those rates set forth in Appendix A of this decision. This authority does not include any deviation from any rates, rules, or regulations except as specifically set forth in Appendix A.
- 2. The authority granted shall expire six months after the effective date of this order unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.
- 3. A public hearing shall be scheduled on this application at a date to be set.
