Order to Cease and Desist

Complainant holds a Class A certificate from this Commission to operate as a charter party carrier of passengers (TCP 207-A). Complainant alleges that on numerous occasions buses belonging to defendant have carried charter-party groups in the Santa Clara Valley to various California cities. Complainant further alleges that at least one specific request for charter service placed with complainant was cancelled and that buses belonging to defendant were used to transport the group in question to its destination.

Complainant alleges that defendant has no authorization from this Commission to act as a charter party carrier of passengers. We here take official notice of the fact that no authorization from this Commission to defendant has been found in the Commission files.

Complainant asks for an order requiring defendant to cease and desist operating as a charter party carrier of passengers pending further order of the Commission. We are of the opinion that good cause has been shown for the issuance of such an order.
