O P I N I O N

Stockton Terminal and Eastern Railroad seeks authority, pursuant to General Order No. 36-D, to abandon its non-agency station at Fairchild, San Joaquin County.

The verified application states that the station is not now required nor likely to be required in the future, and that the existing stations nearest to Fairchild are East Stockton (non-agency), 6.3 miles west, and Linden (non-agency), 6.5 miles east.

Notice of the filing of the application was published in the Commission's Daily Calendar on September 19, 1975. Letters were sent to various interested parties by the staff advising them of the application and that comments or protests to the proposal were to be received by October 31, 1975. No protests have been received.

The Commission finds that:

1. Public convenience and necessity no longer require that Stockton Terminal and Eastern Railroad maintain Fairchild as a non-agency station.
2. A public hearing is not necessary.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted, subject to the conditions set forth in the order which follows:





O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Stockton Terminal and Eastern Railroad is authorized to abandon its non-agency station at Fairchild, San Joaquin County, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, Stockton Terminal and Eastern Railroad shall file, in duplicate, amendments to its tariffs showing the change authorized herein and shall make reference in such tariffs to this decision as authority for this change.
- (b) Within thirty days after the change herein authorized, applicant shall, in writing, notify the Commission thereof.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
