ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Decision No. 82946 dated June 5, 1974 granted Merlin H. Trezona and Mardys R. Trezona (applicant) a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Sacramento and San Francisco. Petition for rehearing was filed on June 14, 1974 by Greyhound Lines, Inc. (Western Division) staying Decision No. 82946. The Commission extended the stay by Decision No. 83286 dated August 6, 1974 to fully evaluate the contentions of the petition for rehearing. Decision No. 83501 dated September 24, 1974 granted rehearing of Decision No. 82946.

Applicant operated as a charter-party carrier under certificate No. TCP 46A until March 31, 1975 at which time said certificate and equipment were transferred to Frank Jaconetti, Jr., doing business as Franks Charter Service.

Applicant was notified by letter on July 24 and October 22, 1975 that the rehearing was pending and that it would be recommended that the application be dismissed unless applicant showed an interest in going forward. No replies to the letters have been received.

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Good cause appearing, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 54251 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
