Application of YANDELL TRUCKAWAY, INC.,
a California corporation, for authority
under Section 3666 of the Public
Utilities Code of the State of
California to deviate from the minimum
rates for the transportation of
beverages in glass or cans for
New Century Beverage, doing business
as Pepsi Cola Bottling Company,
between certain points.

O P I N I O N

Applicant holds radial highway common carrier and highway contract carrier permits. By this application it seeks authority to assess less than the minimum rates for the transportation of beverages in glass bottles or cans for New Century Beverage, doing business as Pepsi Cola Bottling Company, from its bottling facilities located at Emeryville to distributors and customers located in Milpitas, Richmond, Salinas, San Leandro, Stockton, Sunnyvale, Tracy, Woodland, and Yuba City and from bottling facilities located at Sunnyvale to distributors and customers located in Emeryville, Milpitas, Salinas, San Leandro, Stockton, Woodland, and Yuba City.

By interim order in Decision No. 84518 dated June 10, 1975 the relief sought was granted on an interim basis pending hearing. On November 5, 1975 applicant filed an "Application for Final Order of Deviation Authority granted by Interim Decision No. 84518 expiring December 10, 1975" which was filed as a petition for final order. The petition for final order seeks an upward adjustment in the rates previously authorized by Decision No. 84518 and contains cost studies disclosing that operations at the adjusted rates will be compensatory. A description of applicant's operations is set forth in Decision No. 84518 and need not be repeated herein.

No objections to the granting of the application have been received.

Findings

1. The proposed rates are compensatory, reasonable, and justified.
2. A public hearing is not necessary.

The Commission concludes that the application should be granted to the extent set forth in the ensuing order.

Since conditions under which the service is performed may change at any time, the authority granted in the ensuing order will expire at the end of one year unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.

O R D E R


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Yandell Truckaway, Inc. is authorized to depart from the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 by charging those rates set forth in Appendix A of this decision. This authority does not include any deviation from any rates, rules, or regulations except as specifically set forth in Appendix A.
2. The authority granted shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.


3. The authority granted herein supersedes the authority granted by Decision No. 84518.
