ORDER AMENDING DECISION NO. 84871

Decision No. 84871 found that applicant was no longer "engaged in the storage of goods in California" and dismissed the proceeding.

Our staff has called to our attention the fact that the respondent does have a certificated public utility warehouse operation in Buena Park. The phrase in Decision No. 84871 was intended only to indicate that the operation which was the subject matter of the investigation which had served the East Bay Area, was terminated and not moved to another location.

In order that there is no question as to the continued validity of Broadway Warehouses, Inc.'s Buena Park certificate, which was granted by Decision No. 80009,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 84871 is amended to read: "It appearing that respondent is no longer engaged in the public storage of goods in California, except pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 80009,

"IT IS ORDERED that this investigation is discontinued."
