SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Decision No. 84633 was issued in this proceeding on July 8, 1975. Ordering Paragraph 1 directed Bayview Trucking Company, Inc. to pay a fine of \$4,000 pursuant to Public Utilities Code Section 3774 on or before September 13, 1975. Ordering Paragraph 2 directed the payment of \$26,672.08 under Public Utilities Code Section 3800 on or before September 13, 1975. The Commission received a check in the amount of \$12,117 on September 8, 1975. This sum included \$500 of the fine due under the first paragraph of the decision and \$11,617 of the fine due under the second paragraph. A letter dated September 5, 1975 was enclosed with the check. The letter requested that the remainder of the fine due under paragraph 1 be paid in seven monthly installments of \$500 commencing on October 13, 1975 and continuing until the amount is paid in full. It is further requested that the time within which to pay the remaining fine due under paragraph 2 be extended for 180 days to and including May 11, 1976 to provide time to bring a legal action against shipper respondent, M & M Meat Co., who has refused to pay.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision No. 84633 is amended as follows:


Dayview Trucking, Inc. shall pay to this Commission the remaining fine of \$3,500 in seven monthly installments of \$500 together with interest at the rate of 7 percent per annum on the unpaid balance on or before the thirteenth day of each month beginning with the thirteenth day of December 1975.




2. The time within which to pay the fine due under Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision No. 84633 is extended to May 11, 1976.

3. In all other respects Decision No. 84633 shall remain in full force and effect.
