SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER MODIFYING DECISION AND EXTENDING TIME

Upon written request, counsel for Orange Coast Sightseeing Company seeks an amendment to Decision No. 85023 in Application No. 55595.

Presently, Ordering Paragraph 4 in Decision No. 85023 states:

"Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public applicants shall amend their tariffs and timetables to reflect the authority herein granted."

Orange Coast Sightseeing Company requests that Ordering Paragraph 4 be amended so that service may be established within one hundred twenty days and further requests authority to file its tariff and timetable on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public and have such tariff and timetable filings effective concurrent with the establishment of the service authorized by Decision No. 85023.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Ordering Faragraph 4 of Decision No. 85023, dated October 21, 1975, in Application No. 55595, is amended to read as follows:
 - "4. Within one hundred twenty days after November 10, 1975 applicants shall establish the service and file tariffs and timetables in triplicate, in the Commission's office and the tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the

establishment of the authorized service."

In all other respects Decision No. 85023 in

Application No. 55595 shall remain in full force and effect.
