ORDER GRANTING REHEARING AND STAYING DECISION NO. 85086

On November 12, 1975, the Commission issued Decision No. 85086, which granted to Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. (ICS) permission to construct a base station near Loma Linda. This decision was based, in part, on the Commission's determination that the proposed base station and its service area lay within ICS's service area as it existed in 1961. The Commission relied on a map submitted by the Commission staff which showed the proposed station and its service area to be within ICS's original service area. The Commission believed this map to have been constructed in accordance with FCC standards in existence in 1961 for the measurement of UHF field signals. Petitioner has shown that such standards for UHF signals did not exist in 1961 and that the map prepared for the Commission could not have been prepared in conformity therewith.

IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 85086 is hereby granted, said rehearing to be confined to the question of whether the proposed station at Loma Linda and its service area lie within ICS's original service area as it existed in 1961.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Interim Order granting ICS the authority to construct said station be stayed pending further order of the Commission.
