ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 84720 dated July 29, 1975 Preston Trucking Co. was authorized to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of beer from San Francisco to various points in southern California. The authority granted was limited for a period of six months, during which applicant was to collect actual operating data for presentation at a public hearing. The authority will expire January 26, 1976.

Final determination of this matter cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the current authority to April 30, 1976.





IT IS ORDERED that:
