An Order Granting Interim Relief and Order to Show Cause (Decision No. 84724) was issued on July 29, 1975 which ordered defendant to "cease and desist from providing new service under Advice Letter No. 229." A Motion to Dissolve the Order Granting the Interim Relief was filed on August 4, 1975 and public hearings were held on August 22 and September 15, 1975.
