ORDER REVOKING FREIGHT FORWARDER CERTIFICATE

Air Forwarders, Inc. (AFI), a corporation, formerly Domestic Air Express, Inc., possesses a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a freight forwarder between various points in California.

By Resolution No. TS-198 dated September 23, 1975, in Application No. 52318, the Commission suspended the operative right of AFI for failure to amend its tariff to reflect a change in its corporate name and to maintain said tariff on the current level of minimum rates pursuant to Decisions Nos. 84118 and 84539 dated February 19, 1975 and June 17, 1975, respectively. To date AFI has not made the necessary tariff amendments.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the failure of AFI to comply with the aforementioned decisions constitutes good cause for revocation of the operative right and cancellation of the tariff applicable to the services thereunder.

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a freight forwarder granted to Air Forwarders, Inc. by Decision No. 78338, as amended by Decisions Nos. 78924 and 84118 in Application No. 52318, is hereby revoked.

2. Domestic Air Express, Inc., California Intrastate Airfreight Forwarder Tariff No. 1, Cal.P.U.C. No. 1, is hereby cancelled.

The Executive Director is directed to cause service of a certified copy of this order to be made upon Air Forwarders, Inc. or to mail a certified copy thereof to it at its last known address as shown in the Commission's records and to mail a copy of this order to Pacific Coast Tariff Bureau.

The effective date of this order shall be thirty days after the date hereof unless, before such effective date, there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
