ORDER DISCONTINUING INVESTIGATION

By Decision No. 78703 dated May 18, 1971 this Commission initiated an investigation for the purpose of inquiring into a certification procedure under General Order No. 131 to consider the suitability of new plant sites and the environmental compatibility of these sites for use in electric generation. The reasons for issuing Decision No. 78703 have become moot as far as this Commission is concerned because of the creation of the Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission which has been given jurisdiction over new electric plant sites. ✓

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the investigation instituted by Decision No. 78703 is discontinued.
