ORDER GRANTING REHEARING OR RECONSIDERATION  
AND SUSPENDING DECISIONS NOS. 85233,  
85234, 85235, 85236 AND 85237

A petition for suspension, reconsideration or rehearing of Decision No. 85233 has been filed by California Trucking Association. The Commission has considered each and every allegation therein and is of the opinion that good cause for suspension and rehearing exists. Since the modification of the subject credit rules was accomplished in several related decisions, we have further decided to suspend and reconsider Decisions Nos. 85234, 85235, 85236 and 85237.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that

1. Rehearing of Decision No. 85233 is hereby granted;
2. Reconsideration of Decisions Nos. 85234, 85235, 85236, and 85237 is hereby granted;
3. Each ordering paragraph in Decisions Nos. 85233, 85234, 85235, 85236 and 85237, except Ordering Paragraph 7 in Decision No. 85233, is hereby suspended until further order of the Commission;
4. Rehearing of Decision No. 85233 and reconsideration of Decisions Nos. 85234, 85235, 85236 and 85237 shall be heard before such Commissioner and/or such Examiner as may hereafter be designated;
5. The Collection of Charges rules in Minimum Rate Tariffs 2, 3-A, 4-B, 6-B, 8, 10, 11-A, 12, 13, 14-A, 15, and 18 are further amended by incorporating therein to become effective February 1,

1976, Supplement 120 to Minimum Rate Tariff 2, Supplement 9 to Minimum Rate Tariff 3-A, Supplement 32 to Minimum Rate Tariff 4-B, Supplement 6 to Minimum Rate Tariff 6-B, Supplement 44 to Minimum Rate Tariff 8, Supplement 23 to Minimum Rate Tariff 10, Supplement 17 to Minimum Rate Tariff 11-A, Supplement 12 to Minimum Rate Tariff 12, Supplement 4 to Minimum Rate Tariff 13, Supplement 11 to Minimum Rate Tariff 14-A, Supplement 16 to Minimum Rate Tariff 15 and Supplement 10 to Minimum Rate Tariff 18, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

6. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject also to Decisions Nos. 31606, 31602, 55587, 55521, 82350, 33977, 44633, 50114, 50218, 55584, 67397, 65072 or 72418, as amended, are authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendments necessary to conform with the further adjustments of said decision ordered herein.

7. Any provisions currently maintained in common carrier tariffs, which are more restrictive than those contained in Minimum Rate Tariffs 2, 3-A, 4-B, 6-B, 8, 10, 11-A, 12, 13, 14-A, 15, or 18, are authorized to be maintained in connection with the changes authorized by Ordering Paragraph 6.

8. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed not earlier than the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier than the fifth day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than sixty days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.






9. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the changes authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Section 461.5 of the Public Utilities Code to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are hereby modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the changes

published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

10. In all other respects, Decisions Nos. 31606, 31602, 55587, 65521, 82350, 33977, 44633, 50114, 50218, 55584, 67397, 65072 and 72418, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
