ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision No. 84702 dated July 29, 1975 authorized Truman Tilley, doing business as Tiger Charter Lines, to sell and transfer his Class A charter-party carrier of passengers certificate, which was in suspension, to Roland Wilbur. Ordering Paragraph 4 of the decision provided that the certificate shall remain in suspension for an additional period not to exceed six months. The suspension period will expire February 18, 1976.

By letter dated January 8, 1976, Roland Wilbur requests an extension of the suspension period. The letter states that he is negotiating with a buyer for the certificate but that additional time beyond February 18, 1976 will be required to finalize the transaction.

We find that the request is reasonable and conclude that it should be granted.


IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The expiration date of the suspension of the Class A charter-party carrier of passengers certificate referred to in Ordering Paragraph 4 of Decision No. 84702 is extended to August 18, 1976 unless such expiration date is modified by further order of the Commission.


2. In all other respects, Decision No. 84702 shall remain in full force and effect.




