ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 55759 dated October 28, 1957, in Application No. 39283, Willis M. Kleinenbroich, doing business as Modesto Motor Bus Service, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (PSC 758) to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points in Modesto and vicinity.

The Commission was informed by the City of Modesto by letter dated August 23, 1973 that the City would assume operations of Modesto Motor Bus Service.

By a letter dated December 7, 1973, received from Willis M. Kleinenbroich, the Commission was notified that the City of Modesto had taken over the operations of Modesto Motor Bus Service as of November 1, 1973.

Willis M. Kleinenbroich, doing business as Modesto Motor Bus Service, cancelled the Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance on November 5, 1973 and has since had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order No. 101-C.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest.




The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be cancelled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points in Modesto and vicinity authorized by Decision No. 55759 in Application No. 39283 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Willis M. Kleinenbroich, dba Modesto Motor Bus Service, are cancelled upon the effective date of this order.

Box 642, Modesto, California 95353, last known addresses as shown on the Commission's records.
