OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Osterkamp Trucking, Inc., a corporation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with the transportation of fibreboard, paper, paperboard or pulpboard boxes for International Paper Company between Los Angeles (Metropolitan Zone 236) and points in Riverside and Imperial Counties within 190 to 240 miles of said zone.

The application is based upon special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

Applicant asserts that the shipments in question have already commenced to move and expedited action in this matter is necessary because of the seasonal nature of the movement and its dependence to a certain degree on weather conditions.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of December 9, 1975. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.

In view of the urgency in this matter, this order will be made effective on the date hereof.





IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Osterkamp Trucking, Inc., a corporation, is authorized to transport boxes, fibreboard, paper, paperboard or pulpboard, K.D.F., for International Paper Company between Los Angeles (Metropolitan Zone 236) and points in Riverside and Imperial Counties within 190 to 240 miles of said zone at rates less than the applicable minimum rates, but not less than the rates set forth in Appendix A, attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

## APPENDIX A

Osterkamp Trucking, Inc., a corporation, is authorized to transport boxes, fibreboard, paper, paperboard or pulpboard, K.D.F., strapped and banded to pallets for International Paper Company between Los Angeles (Metropolitan Zone 236) and points in Riverside and Imperial Counties within 190 to 240 constructive miles of said zone at the rates indicated:

Constructive Miles

<u>Over</u>	<u>But Not Over</u>	<u>Rates in Cents Per 100 Pounds</u>
190	200	62
200	220	65
220	240	69

Minimum Weight: 45,000 pounds

These rates apply only when shipment is loaded into carrier's equipment by forklift by the consignor and unloaded from carrier's equipment by forklift by the consignee without driver assistance and at no cost to the carrier. The shipping document shall indicate that the shipment was loaded by the consignor and is to be unloaded by the consignee under the conditions herein described. Consignee shall certify unloading in accordance with instructions.

In all other respects, the rates and rules set forth in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 shall apply.
