ORDER OF REVOCATION By Decision 81359 dated May 8, 1973, in Application 53679, Lake Alpine Water Company, Inc., was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Bear Valley Lodge, Alpine County and Day Lodge, Mt. Reba. Since December 16, 1975, Lake Alpine Water Company, Inc., has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 101-C. The carrier also notified the Commission by letter dated December 20, 1975, that it "is no longer running the bus service in Bear Valley, Alpine County." By separate decision the Commission is granting a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Mt. Reba, Inc., for the same operating authority. It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled. - 1 -

A. 53679 VVB IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the points authorized by Decision 81359 in Application 53679 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Lake Alpine Water Company, Inc., are canceled upon the effective date of this order. The Executive Director shall mail a certified copy of this order to Lake Alpine Water Company, Inc., at P.O. Box 121, Bear Valley, CA 95223, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.
