INTERIM ORDER GRANTING PETITIONS TO EXTEND EXPIRATION
DATES OF TEMPORARY CERTIFICATES OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY GRANTED IN DECISION NO. 84814

By interim order in Decision No. 84814 the Commission granted temporary certificates to Air California and Pacific Southwest Airlines to operate as passenger air carriers, respectively, between the Tahoe Valley Airport and certain points in northern California and between the Tahoe Valley Airport and certain points in southern California pending final determination of Applications Nos. 54899 and 55009. The certificates are to expire on March 1, 1976. Air California and Pacific Southwest Airlines have each petitioned the Commission to extend the expiration dates of their temporary certificates.


For the purposes of this order the Commission adopts the findings and conclusions contained in Decision No. 84814 and further finds and concludes that the same facts and conclusions which gave rise to the order in Decision No. 84814 still obtain and that the expiration dates of the temporary certificates should be extended to October 1, 1976.


IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 84814 is modified to read as follows:
