In the matter of the Application of ROBERT L. MOBLEY, an individual, doing business as QUALITY TRANSIT LINES, for authority to institute URBAN SERVICE operations in LAKE ELSINORE TOWN AND AROUND THE LAKE TO LAKELAND VILLAGE AND SEDCO COMMUNITY.

ORDER OF REVOCATION

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Application No. 55088

By Decision 83685 dated November 6, 1974, in Application 55088, Robert L. Mobley, doing business as Quality Transit Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (PSC 958) to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Elsinore, Lakeland Village, Sedco and intermediate points.

It appears that the applicant never accepted the certificate nor did he institute the service.

On February 10, 1975 this Commission received a letter from the applicant in which he states that the "... permit will have to be cancelled. Under the circumstances beyond my control, there is no way to operate a bus line in this area. The City of Lake Elsinore with the help of the federal and county funds will put in its own bus lines ..."

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Elsinore, and Lakeland Village, Sedco and intermediate points authorized by Decision 83685 in Application 55088 is hereby revoked.
