SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 84993 dated October 15, 1975, Robert E. Smith, doing business as Alcal Mail Service, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a highway common carrier between points in and within 10 miles of the San Francisco Territory. The service was to be established 120 days after October 15, 1975. The Commission has been informed that certain difficulties in tariff compilation and misunderstandings as to the time intrastate and interstate service could commence have developed. We now understand that the interstate service can commence March 23, 1976.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraphs 2(b) and 2(c) of Decision No. 84933 are amended to read:





- (b) On or before March 23, 1976 applicant shall establish the authorized service and amend or file tariffs, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff filings shall be made effective not earlier than twenty days after the effective date of this order on not less than twenty days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the authorized service.
