ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REHEARING OF DECISION NO. 85287

On December 30, 1975, the Commission issued Decision No. 85287, granting to The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company a rate increase of \$65.2 million.

On January 9, 1976 a petition for rehearing was filed by the City of San Diego.

The Commission, having considered each and every allegation of the petition, is of the opinion that limited rehearing should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 85287 is hereby granted. Said rehearing is to be limited to the question of whether the estimated revenues and expenses attributed to timing of local messages and increased classified advertising rates should be treated in the same manner as they were in Decision No. 83162, which authorized such revenue increases. Said rehearing shall be heard before Examiner Meaney at 10:00 a.m. on April 12, 1976 in the Commission's courtroom, State Building, San Francisco, California.
