ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 70902, dated June 22, 1966, in Application 40314, El Camino Charter Lines, Inc., was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-595) between Baden Avenue and Airport Boulevard in South San Francisco and Callan and King Drives in Westborough.

The Commission staff observed and informed the carrier by registered mail dated February 27, 1974 that it was not providing the passenger stage service between Westborough and South San Francisco as authorized in the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity issued to El Camino Charter Lines, Inc. The carrier was further informed that the Commission staff would recommend to the Commission that the certificate be revoked for nonuse. The carrier has not replied to the letter.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.






IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Baden Avenue and Airport Boulevard in South San Francisco and Callan

and King Drives in South San Francisco authorized by Decision 70902 in Application 48314 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of El Camino Charter Lines, Inc., are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director of the Commission shall mail a certified copy of this order to El Camino Charter Lines, Inc. at 420 1/2 North Canal, South San Francisco, CA 94060, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof, unless before such effective date there shall have been filed with the Commission written response to this order requesting public hearing in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until further order of the Commission.
