

amended to provide for the volumetric sub-blocking of Priority 4 customers.

Said limited rehearing shall be heard before Examiner Banks on March 29, 1976 at 10:00 A.M. in the Commission Courtroom, State Office Building, 107 South Broadway, Los Angeles.
