## SUPPEEUENGAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision 85317 dated January 6, 2976, in Appiication 55946 authorized the transfer of a portion of the certificate of public convenience and necessity of W111さS Freight Ines to Nielsen Freight Ines and provided for the issuance of in-lieu certificates in appendix form to such carriers. Certain routes were inacivertantly misdescribed in Appenaix A and certain comodity restrictions were inadvertantiy imposed or omitted in Appendix 3.

In the circumstances, it appears and the Comnission finds that the recessary charges should be mace by the order hercin. A public hearing is not necessary. The Comission concludes that Appendices $A$ \& $B$ of Decision 85317 should be amenced accordingly and the effective date of this order should be the date on wich it is signed because there is no know opposition and no reason to delay correcting the misdescriptions.
