Application of FRED JOHN CRIKOS for authority under Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of various aluminum products for Kaiser Aluminum, between certain interplant points.

SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM ORDER

Applicant Fred John Crikos was granted authority to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of certain articles for Kaiser Aluminum by D.84696 dated July 22, 1975. On January 27, 1976 applicant filed a petition for modification of D.84696. The petition was amended on February 17, 1976.

According to the amended petition certain commodities were inadvertently not included in the original rate deviation request. The commodities move from the same plants in substantial quantities as those named in D.84696.

No objection or request for public hearing has been received on the amended petition. We find that the requested modification is justified and conclude that the petition be granted. To avoid undue hardship this order will be made effective on the date hereof.

^{1/} D.84696 was suspended by the timely filing of a Petition for Rehearing filed by the California Trucking Association. D.84957 dated September 30, 1975 denied rehearing.

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- 12. Aluminum Billets, Blooms, Granulated Shot, Ingots, Pigs or Slabs, Item 13240, Class 35, minimum weight 40,000 pounds.
- 13. Plastic Articles, NOI, Item 156600, Sub. 4 and Sub. 5, Class 45, minimum weight 30,000 pounds.
- 14. Plastic Film or Sheeting, other than cellulose, not printed, not embossed, in lengths of not less than 100 feet rolled to a diameter not less than 3 inches, Item 156830, Sub. 1, Class 35, minimum weight 36,000 pounds.

Between: Kaiser Aluminum Plants, warehouses, and storage sites in San Leandro, Newark, South San Francisco, and Permanente and those located in Los Angelos and La Mirada, and customers of Kaiser Aluminum who are located enroute between said interplant points.

Rate: 95 cents per cwt.

Minimum Weight: 40,000 pounds per shipment (per unit of equipment).

- <u>Conditions</u>: (a) Service to customers enroute shall include those located along routes usually and normally traversed.
 - (b) Other than the authority described above, all provisions of Minimum Rate Teriff 2 shall apply.
