O P I N I O N

Bob Brown's Ski and Sport Shops, Inc. presently operates as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-934), transporting passengers and their baggage during the winter snow season between Contra Costa County ski shops on the one hand, and the Kirkwood Meadows Ski Area and Bear Valley Ski Area on the other hand.

By this application, as amended on January 19, 1976, Bob Brown's Ski and Sport Shops, Inc., seeks authority from the Commission to enlarge and modify its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity as follows:

- (1) Add two pickup. points in Berkeley to the passenger stage service.
- (2) Reflect the change of the name of the Concord stop from Bob's Ski and Sports to Wink's Sporting Goods.
- (3) Eliminate the pickup point in Lafayette.
- (4) Change the route between the Concord stop and the Antioch stop.

The applicant indicates that there is no other scheduled passenger stage service operating between the East Bay and Kirkwood Meadows.

The applicant alleges that there are numerous requests from the public in the Berkeley area for direct pickup service to Kirkwood Meadows.

Notice of filing of this application and the amendment appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar on December 30, 1975 and January 23, 1976, respectively. No protests have been received.

The Commission's Transportation Division staff has reviewed the application and recommends that it be granted.

After consideration, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the extension and enlargement of applicant's service as proposed. The requested revision of its existing route is reasonable. The Commission also finds with reasonable certainty that this project will not have a significant effect on the environment. A public hearing is not necessary.

The application, as amended, should be granted and Appendix A of Decision 82982 should be revised accordingly. To accommodate passengers during this winter ski season the order should be made effective on the date hereof.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is granted to Bob Brown's Ski and Sport Shops, Inc., authorizing it to extend its present operations as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, between the points and over the routes set forth in Appendix A of Decision 82982, as amended by the revised pages attached hereto.

2. Appendix A of Decision 82982 in Application 54430 is further amended by incorporating therein First Revised Pages 2, 3 and 4 in revision of Original Pages 2, 3 and 4, respectively, which revised pages are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. In providing service pursuant to the authority granted by this order, applicant shall comply with the following service regulations. Failure to do so may result in a cancelation of the authority.


- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate granted. Applicant is placed on notice that if it accepts the certificate it will be required, among other things, to comply with the safety rules administered by the California Highway Patrol, the rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order 93-Series, and the insurance





requirements of the Commission's Genral Order 101-Series.

- (b) Within one hundred twenty days after the effective date of this order, applicant shall establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables, in triplicate, in the Commission's office.
- (c) The tariff and timetable filings shall be made effective not earlier than five days after the effective date of this order on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, and the effective date of the tariff and timetable filings shall be concurrent with the establishment of the authorized service.
- (d) The tariff and timetable filings made pursuant to this order shall comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of tariffs and timetables set forth in the Commission's General Orders 79-Series and 98-Series.
- (e) Applicant shall maintain its accounting records on a calendar year basis in conformance with the applicable Uniform System of Accounts or Chart of Accounts as prescribed or adopted by this Commission and shall file with the Commission, on or before March 31 of each year, an annual report of its operations in such form, content and number of copies as the Commission, from time to time, shall prescribe.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS
AND SPECIFICATIONS.

*Bob Brown's Ski and Sport Shops, Inc., a California corporation, by the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity granted by the Decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between Bob's Ski and Sport Shops in San Pablo, Harbert's Brothers' Sporting Goods and Benson's Sporting Goods in Berkeley, Sports Unlimited in Orinda, Wink's Sporting Goods in Concord, and Palace Sporting Goods in Antioch, on the one hand, and Kirkwood Meadows ski area or Bear Valley ski area, on the other hand, over and along the routes hereinafter described, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify said routes at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) Motor vehicles may be turned at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersections, in accordance with local traffic regulations.
- (b) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- (c) Service shall be operated on a round-trip schedule every Saturday, Sunday and holiday during the California winter ski season only.
- (d) The carrier shall transport only those passengers whose travel is between Antioch or westerly thereof, on the one hand, and the points of Kirkwood Meadows ski area or Bear Valley ski area, on the other hand.
- (e) The carrier shall provide service to and from only the above-named stopping points in Contra Costa and Alameda Counties.

SECTION 2 ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS

- *ROUTE NO. 1 - Between East Bay Ski Shops and Kirkwood Meadows ski area, commencing at Bob's Ski and Sport Shops located at 14012 San Pablo Avenue, San Pablo, then eastbound via San Pablo Avenue, El Portal Drive, San Pablo Dam Road, Camino Pablo, and Orinda Way to Sports Unlimited located at 21 Orinda Way, Orinda; then via Orinda Way, State Highway 24, Treat Blvd, and Oak Grove Road to Wink's Sporting Goods located at 1703 Oak Grove Road, Concord; then via Oak Grove Road, Ignacio Valley Road, Kirker Pass Road, State Highway 4, and "A" Street to Palace Sporting Goods located at 1619 "A" Street, Antioch; then via "A" Street, State Highway 4, State Highway 160, State Highway 12, and State Highway 88 to Kirkwood Meadows ski area
- *ROUTE NO. 2 - Commencing at Harbert's Brothers Sporting Goods at 2338 Shattuck Avenue, Berkeley, then eastbound via Shattuck Avenue, Ashby Avenue to College Avenue, to Benson's Sporting Goods at 2997 College Avenue (College at Ashby), then via Ashby, State Highway 24, Orinda Way to Sports Unlimited located at 21 Orinda Way, Orinda, to join with and proceed via Route 1 as described above, to Kirkwood Meadows ski area.

*First Alternate Route - Between Antioch and Bear Valley ski area. Commencing at Palace Sporting Goods located at 1619 "A" Street, Antioch, then via "A" Street, State Highway 4 to Bear Valley ski area.

Second Alternate Route - Between Martell and Angels Camp. Commencing at junction of State Highway 88 and State Highway 49, in or near Martell, then via State Highway 49 to junction of State Highway 49 and State Highway 4 in or near Angels Camp.
