## ORDER GRANTING INTERTM RELIEF

The verified complaint alleges that:

1. Complainant receives telephone service from defendant under her professional name of Jessica Treharne. Complainant's telephone number is (415) 763-1542.
2. On or about March 25, 1976, without notice to complainant, and in violation of its tariff, defendant disconnected complainant's telephone service for the alleged nonpayment of charges in the amount of $\$ 38.43$.
3. Complainant offered to pay $\$ 38.43$ for the restoration of service, but defendant refused to reconnect service unless compiainant also made a deposit of $\$ 150$.

At the time of filing of this complaint, the complainant deposited with the Comission the sum of $\$ 38.43$.

The Comission finds and concludes that sufficient facts have been alleged for the granting of interim relief.

IT IS ORDERED that defendant shall restore complainant's telephone service for the number (415) 763-1542 until further order of this Commission, provided, however, that defendant may discontinue service in accordance with its tariff if complainant does not pay for future service rendered when such payments become due.
