ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this application, filed February 13, 1976, Pacific Southwest Airlines seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity as an express corporation.

By letter dated February 19, 1976, and received February 24, 1976, the attorney for applicant requests withdrawal of the application and refund of the accompanying filing fee of \$500. No reason for withdrawal of the application was given.

The filing of the application does not appear to have been made in error and as no reason for withdrawal has been offered which would warrant the authorization of the refund of the filing fee to applicant, that request will be denied.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Application No. 56276 filed by Pacific Southwest Airlines is dismissed.

2. The request for refund of the accompanying filing fee of \$500 is denied.
