ORDER OF SUSPENSION

2. Minimum Rate Tariff 9-B (Appendix A of Decision 67766, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective April 17, 1976, Sixteenth Revised Page 17, which page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

3. Minimum Rate Tariff 19 (Appendix A of Decision 41363, as amended) is further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective April 17, 1976, Fifteenth Revised Page 15-A, which page is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.
