ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Since filing this application County Water Co. of Riverside, Inc. (Riverside) has failed to proceed on the application with any reasonable degree of diligence. Repeatedly, by letter and by telephone, the staff has requested various data necessary to process the application. On occasion Riverside has responded with bits and pieces; on other occasions there has been no response.

On September 29, 1975 the Executive Director of the Commission advised Riverside that further processing would be deferred until such time as the requested data was furnished. On January 23, 1976 the examiner advised Riverside that the Commission proposed to dismiss the application without prejudice unless there was compliance with the staff requests. At this time both Finance and Accounts and the Utilities Divisions advise of noncompliance and minimal cooperation from Riverside and recommend dismissal without prejudice.

The Commission therefore concludes that Riverside is not interested at this time in pursuing this application.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 55678 is dismissed without prejudice.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
