ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 76545 dated December 16, 1969, in Application 51449, Donald F. Wallace, doing business as Mt. Hamilton Stage Line was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (PSC 866) to operate as a passenger stage corporation between San Jose and Mt. Hamilton and intermediate points.

Since August 27, 1973, Donald F. Wallace, doing business as Mt. Hamilton Stage Line, has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 101-C.

By letter of September 7, 1974, Donald F. Wallace informed this Commission that he had discontinued service since June 1973 and stated he did not anticipate any further need for this type of service.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between San Jose and Mt. Hamilton and intermediate points thereto, authorized by Decision 76545 in Application 51449 is hereby revoked and all

effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Donald F. Wallace, doing business as Mt. Hamilton Stage Line, are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The Executive Director of the Commission shall mail a certified copy of this order to Donald F. Wallace at 5002 Noella Way, San Jose, CA 95129, last known address as shown on the Commission's records.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
