ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The complaint was filed on March 25, 1976. On March 31, 1976 the Commission entered an Order Granting Interim Relief (D.85657) which ordered restoration of complainant's telephone service pending disposition of this matter. On April 1, 1976 complainant filed a request for dismissal with prejudice.

The Commission finds that:

- 1. The \$38.43 deposited by complainant with the Commission at the time of filing the complaint should be transmitted to defendant.
 - 2. The Order Granting Interim Relief should be terminated.
- 3. The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice.

 The Commission concludes that the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice in accordance with the facts heretofore made.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The Executive Director is directed to transmit the sum of \$38.43 to defendant The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company.
- The Order Granting Interim Relief in Decision No. 85657 is hereby terminated.
- 3. The above-entitled complaint is dismissed with prejudice. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
