ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision No. 84720 dated July 29, 1975 Preston Trucking Co. was authorized to deviate from the minimum rates for the transportation of beer from San Francisco to various points in southern California. That authority will expire April 30, 1976.

Hearing on this matter was held March 23 and 24, 1976, with further hearing scheduled April 13, 1976.

Final determination cannot be accomplished before the current authority expires. It is appropriate, therefore, to extend the present authority to June 30, 1976.

## IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The authority granted by Decision No. 84720 shall expire on June 30, 1976 unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 84720 shall remain in full force and effect.
