ORDER OF REVOCATION By Decision 73841, dated June 22, 1971, in Application 52566, David L. Ritter, doing business as Tahoe Transit Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (PSC-892) to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points on the South Shore of Lake Tahoe. Since March 17, 1972, David L. Ritter, doing business as Tahoe Transit Lines, has had no evidence on file with this Commission showing adequate protection against liability imposed by law for payment of damage for personal injury or property damage, as required by General Order 101-C. By letter dated June 10, 1974, the City of South Lake Tahoe informed this Commission that Tahoe Transit Lines was no longer conducting the bus operations. It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforenamed certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled. IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points on the South Shore of Lake Tahoe authorized by Decision 78841 in Application 52566 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs

A. 52566 - FS and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of David L. Ritter, doing business as Tahoe Transit Lines, are canceled upon the effective date of this order. The Executive Director of the Commission shall mail a certified copy of this order to David L. Ritter, doing business as Tanoe Transit Lines at P.O.
