ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision 73507, dated December 19, 1967, in Application 49403, Walter E. Mendenhall and Wilbur N. Mendenhall, doing business as Mendenhall Transportation Company, were granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (PSC-125) to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized to transport passengers, baggage and packages of express weighing 100 pounds or less on passenger-carrying vehicles only between Eureka, Fortuna, Rohnerville and Ruth, including intermediate points.

By letter dated August 14, 1974, Walter E. Mendenhall has requested the revocation of the passenger stage corporation authority granted to Mendenhall Transportation Company by Decision 73507, in Application 49403.

It appears and the Commission finds that these matters constitute good cause for the revocation of the aforementioned certificate and that such revocation would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes that the certificate should be revoked and that tariffs and timetables applicable to the service thereunder should be canceled.




IT IS ORDERED that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation authorized to transport passengers, baggage and packages of express weighing 100 pounds or less on passenger-carrying vehicles only between the points

authorized by Decision 73507, in Application 49403 is hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Walter E. Mendenhall and Wilbur N. Mendenhall, doing business as Mendenhall Transportation Company, are canceled upon the effective date of this order.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after the date hereof.
