ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Continental Telephone Company on February 10, 1976, requested in writing an extension of time of four months in the reporting requirements of Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 82129 dated November 13, 1973. The request is made so that actual settlement cost study results can be used to generate the study ordered by Ordering Paragraph No. 2 at considerable savings in time and effort.

It appears that the request is in the public interest. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:




1. Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 82129 is modified to read:

Continental, within ten months of the establishment of extended area service authorized herein, shall report to the Commission, in writing, the actual revenue effect, actual expense change, actual incremental EAS and toll investment change, actual cost of ownership change, and net effect based on the first full three months of EAS operations.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 82129 shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority granted herein shall become effective on the date hereof.
