ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Continental Telephone Company on February 10, 1976, requested in writing an extension of time of four months in the reporting requirements of Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 82390 dated January 29, 1974. The request is made so that actual settlement cost study results can be used to generate the study ordered by Condition No. 2 at considerable savings in time and effort.

IT IS ORDERED that:

l. Ordering Paragraph No. 2 of Decision No. 82390 is modified to read:

Within ten months of the establishment of 1-EAS and OCMS in the Modesto area, Continental and Pacific shall report to the Commission, in writing, the actual revenue effect, actual expense change, actual incremental investment changes, actual cost of ownership change, and net effect based on the first full three months of 1-EAS and OCMS operations.

2. In all other respects Decision No. 82390 shall remain in full force and effect.

The authority granted herein shall become effective on the date hereof.
