ORDER RESCINDING DECISION 83307

By Decision 83307, dated August 20, 1974, in Application 54731, Steven F. Costa, dba Mountain Stage Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Wrightwood and San Bernardino and intermediate points.

In Ordering Paragraph 2 (a) of Decision 83307, the carrier was required to file a written acceptance of the certificate granted within thirty days after August 20, 1974. Applicant in his letter dated September 16, 1974 informed this Commission that "Due to changed personnel circumstances it will not be possible to establish Mountain Stage Lines as proposed at this time. I am, therefore, notifying the Commission that I am not accepting the certificate granted."

It appears and the Commission finds that there is good cause for rescinding Decision 83307.


IT IS ORDERED that Decision 83307 is rescinded.


