OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Warren Trucking Co., Inc., a corporation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 2 in connection with transportation of newsprint paper and printing paper from various warehouses located in the vicinity of the Los Angeles Harbor and Long Beach to various points in southern California.<sup>1</sup>

<sup>1</sup> The minimum and proposed rates in cents per 100 pounds for representative shipments of the aforementioned commodities are as follows:

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of March 8, 1976. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order.





IT IS ORDERED that:

APPENDIX A

Warren Trucking Co. Inc., a corporation, is authorized to transport newsprint paper and printing paper from Los Angeles Harbor, Long Beach and other points in the Los Angeles Harbor Commercial Zone to various points in southern California at not less than the rates set forth in its Local and Proportional Freight Tariff No. 2, IF-I.C.C. No. 11 (Exhibit A attached to Application 56313).

This authority is subject to the following conditions:

1. This authority is limited to shipments having had a prior movement in interstate commerce and being reshipped to final destination after temporary storage from a warehouse location in Los Angeles County.
2. Applicant has not indicated subhaulers will be engaged nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein.
