OPINION AND ORDER

By this application, Bulk Transportation, a corporation, requests authority to deviate from the provisions of Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A in connection with transportation of silica sand for Glass Container Corporation from Mission Viejo, located 5 miles east of San Juan Capistrano, to Vernon.¹

The application is based on special circumstances and conditions detailed therein.

Revenue and expense data submitted by applicant indicate that the transportation involved may reasonably be expected to be profitable under the proposed rates.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 26, 1976. No objection to the granting of the application has been received.

¹The present and proposed rates for this transportation are respectively 339 cents per ton, minimum weight 23 tons, and 240 cents per ton, minimum weight 28 tons. It is also proposed to assess a rate of \$3.00 for each 15 minutes or fraction thereof for loading or unloading time in excess of one hour.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant's proposal is reasonable. A public hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that the application should be granted as set forth in the ensuing order and the effective date of this order should be the date hereof because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Bulk Transportation, a corporation, is authorized to perform the transportation shown in Appendix A attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof at not less than the rates set forth therein.

2. The authority granted herein shall expire one year after the effective date of this order unless sooner cancelled, modified or extended by further order of the Commission.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.

APPENDIX A

Carrier: Bulk Transportation
Commodity: Silica Sand
For: Glass Container Corporation
From: Mission Viejo production plant of Owens-Illinois, Inc., located five miles east of Interstate Highway 5 on California State Highway 74, in the City of San Juan Capistrano.
To: Glass Container Corporation, 3601 Santa Fe Avenue, Vernon, California
Rate: \$2.40 per ton
Minimum Weight: 28 tons
Accessorial Charges: Loading and unloading time in excess of one hour to be charged at the rate of \$3.00 for each 15 minutes or fraction thereof.

Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be engaged nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rate authorized herein.

In all other respects the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A apply.
