SUPPLEMENTAL INTERIM SURCHARGE SUPPLEMENT AND ORDER

It has come to the Commission's attention that the author-
ity granted by Decision 85755 dated April 27, 1976, in these
proceedings does not reflect the intent of said decision with respect
to certain parcel rates in Items 265, 850, 420 and 425 of Minimum
Rate Tariffs 2, 1-B, 9-B and 19, respectively.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds that the neces-
sary corrections should be made by the order herein. A public
hearing is not necessary. The Commission concludes that Minimum
Rate Tariffs 2, 1-B, 9-B and 19 should be amended accordingly.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph 1 of Decision 85755 is hereby amended
by substituting therefor the following:

"1. Minimum Rate Tariffs 1-B, 2, 9-B and 19 are further
amended effective May 15, 1976, to provide that
charges resulting thereunder (except C.O.D. charges;




charges resulting from the use of railhead to railhead rates applied under the alternative application of common carrier rates and charges resulting under the provisions of Items 265, 850, 420 and 425 of Minimum Rate Tariffs 2, 1-B, 9-B and 19, respectively) on shipments subject to any quantity rates and rates subject to minimum weights of less than 10,000 pounds shall be increased by four and one-half (4 1/2) percent and those 10,000 pounds and over by three (3) percent."

2. In all other respects, Decision 85755, shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order is the date hereof.
