The City of Simi Valley requests authority to construct a new grade separation structure, to be known as the 'Madera Road Overhead", over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's main line in the City of Simi Valley, Ventura County.

The priority list of grade separation projects for the fiscal year 1975-76, as set forth in Decision 84530, shows this project as Priority 23.

The City of Simi Valley is the lead agency for the Madera Interchange and Ramp Project, which includes the 'Madera Road Overhead", pursuant to the Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as amended. The city furnished a copy of an 'Environmental Assessment" prepared by Ultrasystems, Inc. of Newport Beach, California and "Notice of Determination" State Clearinghouse Number SCH 75031137 in which it stated that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.

Notice of the application was published in the Commission's Daily Calendar on January 21, 1976. No protests have been received. A public hearing is not necessary.

A.56199 bs/TLR\* COHCLUSIOMS On the basis of the foregoing findings, we conclude that the application should be granted as set forth in the following order: IT IS ORDERED that: 1. The City of Simi Valley is authorized to construct Madera Road Overhead at separated grades over the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company's main line in the City of Simi Valley, Ventura County, as set forth in the findings of this decision. 2. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within three years unless time be extended or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.
