
ORDER EXTENDING TIME


Applicant has requested the Commission to amend its order extending time in Decision No. 82864, Application No. 51681, so that applicant may have more time within which to exercise its certificate of public convenience and necessity. The request appears to be reasonable, in that the Federal Power Commission has not yet acted on the license application, and the Commission finds and concludes that the extension should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that the time limit for exercising the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by Decision No. 82864 is extended to and including April 27, 1978.
