APPENDIX A

R. Cali & Bros., a corporation, is authorized to transport Fibreboard Boxes, other than corrugated, knocked down flat, for Container Corporation of America between Santa Clara and points in Fresno County at a rate of 59 cents per 100 pounds, subject to a minimum weight of 30,000 pounds.

Conditions:

- 1. Applicant has not indicated that subhaulers will be engaged nor have any costs of subhaulers been submitted. Therefore, if subhaulers are employed, they shall be paid no less than the rates authorized herein.
- 2. In all other respects, the rates and rules in Minimum Rate Tariff 2 shall apply.
