NO. 85883 BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of MARINO BROS. TRUCKING CO., for an order authorizing departure from the rates, rules and regulations of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 pursuant to the provisions of Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of glass, flat, not bent, from Lathrop to various points in Southern California for Libbey-Owens-Ford Company.

Application No. 56118 (Filed December 12, 1975; amended April 12, 1976)

INTERIM OPINION

Applicant Marino Bros. Trucking Co., a corporation, is a highway permit carrier. By this application authority is sought to depart from the established minimum rates for the transportation of glass, flat, not bent, as described in Item 86730 of the National Motor Freight Classification from Lathrop to various central and southern California points for the account of Libbey-Owens-Ford Company. The proposed rates are generally equivalent to those applicable to rail movements of the same commodity between the same points. The proposed rates are about 80 percent of the applicable minimum rates. Applicant requests authority to institute the proposed rates immediately, and that if formal hearing is necessary, interim relief be granted pending hearing.

Applicant has served the Libbey-Owens-Ford Company for the past five years. The financial data attached to the amended application indicate that applicant is financially sound and has apparently conducted past operations profitably. The financial data include operations performed for Libbey-Owens-Ford Company and it is assumed that those services were conducted, to some degree, at rate levels equivalent to the rail rates.

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The study of revenue and expenses for the proposed operation shows that a return movement is required in many instances in order that the round-trip revenue will exceed round-trip expenses. The source of the return trip traffic is not disclosed. It is also not revealed whether the operation will utilize the service of underlying carriers. The income statement for the year ended December 31, 1975 indicates that underlying carriers are extensively employed.

Interim authority will be granted pending hearing. The authority will be restricted to services performed with applicant's equipment. Applicant will be expected to produce evidence which will reflect actual operating revenue and expenses, which must include return movements. If underlying carriers are employed, the expenses of such carriers will be required.

In order to give applicant maximum time to secure data and to avoid undue hardship as a result of further delay, the following order will be made effective on this day.

INTERIM ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Marino Bros. Trucking Co. is authorized to depart from the minimum rates set forth in Minimum Hate Tariff 2 by charging those rates set forth in Appendix A of this decision. The authority does not include any deviation from any rates, rules, or regulations except as specifically set forth in Appendix A.

2. The authority granted shall expire six months after the effective date of this order unless sooner canceled, modified, or extended by order of the Commission.

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3. A public hearing shall be scheduled on this application at a date to be set.
