ORDER RESCINDING DECISION 83528

By Decision 83528, dated October 1, 1974, in Application 54394 Betty Jean Tibbetts, doing business as Blue Bus Lines, was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Ukiah and Willits and intermediate points.

In Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision 83528, the applicant was required to file: (1) A written acceptance of the certificate granted on or before November 20, 1974; (2) Tariffs and timetables on or before February 13, 1975; and (3) Certificate of Insurance, in compliance with the insurance requirements of General Order 101-C, on or before the day passenger stage operations commenced.

Applicant has not complied with any of these requirements.

It appears and the Commission finds that there is good cause for rescinding Decision 83528.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 83528 is rescinded.


